

## Scoring Tips

### Batting Team

The numbers along the top represent each ball they face and the score achieved. The scoresheet has provision for 60 balls per player. This makes it easy to determine when each player has reached their allocated number of balls. I have used X's below to indicate when a player is dismissed. N.B. Do not record runs for sundries such as wides, byes, etc. It should only show runs off the bat. Anything else should be a dot. That way it is easy to add up the batter score. If a player retires after their allocated balls suggest circle their final ball.

## Bowling

The numbers long the top represent the number of overs they have bowled. Each square represents a ball bowled and the outcome of the delivery, e.g. runs scored, byes, wickets, etc. The summary block for each over captures the accumulated total of wickets and runs. When a bowler bowls a maiden simply place an M in the over summary. In the example below the bowler has figures of 1 wicket for 4 runs after 3 overs, and has bowled 1 maiden.
